

COBB TUNING PRODUCTS LLC ACCESSTUNER PRO SUBSCRIPTION FEE SCHEDULE

Effective October 1, 2017, this Subscription fee policy serves as an addendum to the COBB Accesstuner Pro Terms and Conditions and COBB may modify, discontinue, or change this document at COBB's sole discretion.

SECTION 1. FEES, PAYMENT, TAXES

1.1 Fees. Subscription fees are billed on a monthly schedule and the total billed is a function of the number of total software suites used by Licensee. If there is an increase in the number of Software Suites used by Licensee, Subscription fees will be adjusted accordingly for the entirety of the current Subscription Term. If there is a decrease in the number of Software Suites used by Licensee, Subscription fees will be adjusted for the following Subscription Term.

- 1 Software Suite = \$100
- 2 Software Suite = \$120
- 3 Software Suite = \$140
- 4 Software Suite = \$160
- 5 Software Suite = \$180
- 6 Software Suite = \$200
- 7 Software Suite = \$220

1.2 Payment. Continuing through the Subscription Term, each licensee will be charged the applicable Subscription fees on, or around the beginning of each month. If you are an existing Protuner that does not have an active payment method on file, please contact Protuner support and provide payment details. While we will make every effort to notify you, your License may be deactivated without notice if a successful payment cannot be made or payment method is not on file.

1.3 Taxes. All amounts payable by Licensee to COBB under this Agreement are exclusive of any tax, levy, VAT or other relevant governmental charge that may be assessed by any jurisdiction ("Taxes") and Licensee agree to pay such Taxes. If, as a result of any tax or levy, Licensee is required to withhold any amount on any payment to COBB, then the amount of the payment to COBB shall be automatically increased to totally offset such tax, so that the amount actually remitted to COBB, net of all Taxes, equals the amount invoiced or otherwise due. Licensee will promptly furnish COBB with the official receipt of payment of these taxes to the appropriate taxing authority. If Licensee is tax-exempt, Licensee shall provide COBB with a certificate of exemption acceptable to the taxing authority.
